





## **Ergophone S 500**

### Analog ergonomic telephone

The "Ergophone S 500" offers intelligent technology that convinces in its simplicity. Besides the excellent voice and audio quality and the consistently ergonomics, the phone provides a number of security features that ensure reliable and flexible communications in emergencies. The phone is designed for connection to analog ports of PBXs. It do not need batteries or a power adapter<sup>1</sup>.



#### **Features**

#### Extra large display

- LCD graphic display, 240 x 64 dots
- Display messages in 5 languages switchable
- Indication of date, time and call duration
- Brightness of display adjustable

#### Extra large keys

- · Large ergonomic keys with good pressure point
- Key "5" with orientation point

#### Telephone features

- Dialling with offline call preparation
- Automatic disconnection of the line by engaged tone recognition
- Redial from the call list
- Easy menu guidance (suppression of functions reserved to authorized persons. Activation via PIN code)
- Call list of incoming and outgoing calls (20 entries), missed calls are signaled via LED and cleartext
- Indication of the last incoming number (CLIP)<sup>2</sup>
- Phonebook for 50 entries (name and number)
- Transfer of call list entries to the phonebook
- 7 speed dialling keys with name plates
- Service-key (only programmable with PIN-code)

- 10 memories (abbreviated dialling)

- Loudspeaker volume adjustable. Extra loud if desired<sup>4</sup>.
- Handset volume adjustable via slide switch. Extra loud if desired.
- Handset to hearing aid compatible

#### Visual displays

- Ringing indication via display
- LED for missed calls/fault messages (on/off)



# Ergophone \$ 500 Features, continuation

#### Safety functions

- Emergency call function (separate emergency key with reassurance-LED, 9 emergency numbers can be stored, automatic switch to hands-free mode after acknowledgement via key 5, automatic hang up, special emergency call parameters programmable)<sup>5</sup>
- Auto answer mode (after calling the phone switches into monitoring mode). Activation via "number of rings" or CLIP<sup>2</sup> number or special call
- Fault message if the telephone network or the power grid fails<sup>4</sup>. Automatic call if the power grid fails<sup>4</sup>.
- Test call (automatic call to stored phone numbers at a specified time)
- Log in/out of the caregiver via key (documentation of presence)

#### **Basic settings**

- Personal identification number (PIN) programmable
- Dialling mode: tone
- Connection to a PABX possible (programmable signal key flash and CO-line code)
- Exception numbers (e.g. police/fire service numbers for a specific country) programmable
- CLIP mode<sup>2</sup> (rated CLIP or DTMF-CLIP) switchable
- Headset mode
- Date/time on/off switchable

#### Configuration/software-update

- Configuration via phone-menu/web-browser and transfer to other phones via SD card
- Software-update via SD card
- Check out: All non-PIN-protected functions are set to the factory setting.
